WINE ORIGIN

Owner : Isabelle Courrèges.

Appellation : AOP Ajaccio.

Terroir: Hillsides of granitic sandy soils

Climate: Nearly 3,000 hours of sunshine, low rainfall; the vineyard is located in southern Corsica, 10 km from the sea.

GRAPE VARIETY AND VINIFICATION

Sciaccarello, which means “crunchy to the bite,” is a Corsican grape variety with medium-sized berries, low in anthocyanins but highly aromatic. Direct pressing, followed by cold enzymatic settling (around 10°C) for 24 hours, then yeast is added and fermentation takes place at a controlled temperature of 14-16°C for approximately 12 to 18 days.

TASTING NOTES

A beautiful pale color with salmon hues, offering an open nose of citrus fruits such as clementines and grapefruit. It delights with its freshness and roundness on the palate.

SERVIING

Serve between 10°C and 12°C. This easy-drinking wine is perfect for summer cuisine.
